of Novembre Numérique

For the first time, Ghana will join the global celebration of Novembre Numérique.

Alliance Française d'Accra, in partnership with Leti Arts are hosting Ghana's inaugural edition from 5th to 7th November 2025 at Alliance Française Accra.

The three-day festival features leading digital creators and organizations, offering exhibitions, discussions, and interactive experiences. It aims to inspire the next generation of digital experts and enthusiasts, while strengthening Ghana's growing digital and creative ecosystem.

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Novembre Numérique – The Digital Cultures Festival

Novembre Numérique (Digital November) is an annual global event initiated by the Institut français and the French cultural network abroad, celebrating digital cultures in all their forms. Launched in 2017, it brings together artists, innovators, and audiences worldwide to explore the creative, social, and technological dimensions of the digital world.

Every November, the festival highlights the diversity and vitality of French digital creation, from immersive experiences, video games, and esports, to digital arts, podcasts, web creation, and innovative publishing. It provides a space for dialogue, experimentation, and collaboration across cultures, uniting creators, professionals, and the public around shared questions of technology, creativity, and innovation.

In 2024, Novembre Numérique reached over 70 countries and 130 cities, through both in-person and online events. This growing mobilization reflects the Institut français' commitment to expanding access to new technologies and to supporting the international visibility of French digital artists and creators.

Novembre Numérique 2025: Focus Areas

The 2025 edition places special emphasis on two key themes:

Artificial Intelligence (AI) – in the wake of the Summit for Action on Artificial Intelligence held in France in February 2025, projects exploring AI's creative potential, challenges, and impacts will receive particular attention.

Digital Heritage – the digital enhancement of French heritage and collections will also be a featured focus.

Through Novembre Numérique, France reaffirms its belief that digital culture is not only a tool for communication but also a powerful medium for artistic expression, cultural exchange, and global connection.

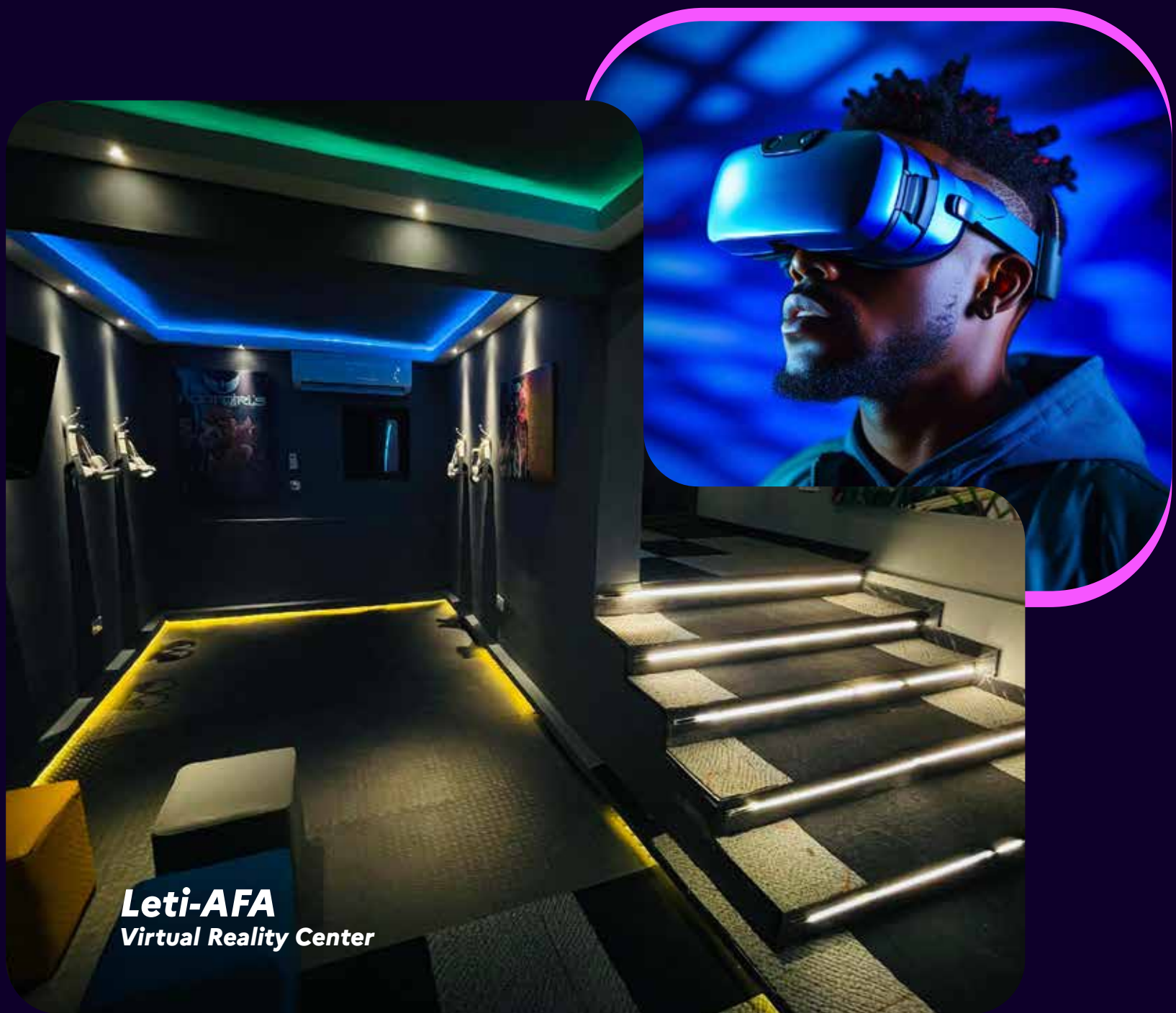
